**N.B. Of Ferias in Lent** they are privileged and as such MUST be commemorated by Collect(s) and Gospel if another Office is celebrated, otherwise it is always acceptable and traditional to commemorate a feast day similarly and observe the Lenten Feria. **Of Requiems in Lent**, votive Requiems are forbidden, only obsequial Requiems are permitted.

## ORDO Kalendarium Martius 2019

**Classes of Feasts** are indicated in the title of any given day by the font format: **MAJOR DOUBLES** i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> Class Doubles are Capitalised in Bold; 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Doubles are CAPITALISED; Doubles are Sentence-case Text (Doubles and above are feasts when the antiphons at the psalms in the Offices are said in full); **Semi-Doubles** are sentence case in bold and italic and *Simplex* feasts are simply italicised (only the opening words of the antiphons with the whole antiphon at the end).

**Commemorations** are indicated in the Ordo chart as the Secunda oration “2a” or Tertiary oration “3a” with the first words or name of the feast/saint being commemorated. Also indicated are the *Orationes Pro Diversitate Temporum Assignatae* found in the Missal that are offered in Sunday and Ferial Masses.

### Of Orations “Orationes pro diversitate temporum assignata”

From Candlemass to Ash Wednesday; at Mass the second oration after the Collect is 2a. is “Ad poscenda suffragia Sanctorum” (for the intercession of the saints) which begins “A cunctis nos, quaesumus” the third oration 3a. “Contra persecutores” (for the church) which begins “Protégé nos, Domine”.

**GREAT BRITAIN KALENDAR** *the following feasts replace the Office given in the kalendar above*

### ASH WEDNESDAY

The rite of blessing the ashes is similar to that of blessing candles at Candlemas. The colour is purple for both blessing and Mass. No ornaments are used on the altar, except the cross and six candles (for High Mass). The altar-cards may either be on the altar from the beginning of the function, or they may be put in their place before Mass begins. The missal, covered with purple, stands on the epistle side; near it, between the book and the end of the altar, is a vessel containing the ashes, made by burning palms from last Palm Sunday. This vessel is covered with a purple veil or a lid. At the credence table everything is prepared for Mass, as usual. There is, moreover, the vessel of holy water and sprinkler, the broad stole for the deacon (if the ministers wear folded chasubles), water in a vessel, a basin, towel and plate with dry bread, that the celebrant may wash his hands after the distribution of ashes. The function begins after none.

### SEASON OF LENT

On Ash Wednesday and the three following days the office is said as on other ferias of the year, though they have special collects, antiphons at the Magnificat and Benedictus, and ferial "preces." The Lenten order of the office does not begin till the first Sunday of Lent. The organ is silent throughout the season except where it is necessary to accompany the singing of hymns. By Tradition the Ferial Office in Lent generally takes precedence. Feasts in Lent when observed must always include a commemoration of the Lent Feria by its collect and its gospel as the Last Gospel. Similarly when feasts are commemorated on the Feria, they are commemorated by their collect and gospel as the last.
