NOTA BENE

Classes of Feasts are indicated in the title of any given day by the font format: **MAJOR DOUBLES** i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> Class Doubles are Capitalised in Bold; 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Doubles are CAPITALISED; Doubles are Sentence-case Text (Doubles and above are feasts when the antiphons at the psalms in the Offices are said in full); **Semi-Doubles** are sentence case in bold and italic and *Simplex* feasts are simply italicised (only the opening words of the antiphons with the whole antiphon at the end).

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## ORDO Kalendarium Aprilis 2019

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**Commemorations** are indicated in the Ordo chart as the Secunda oration “2a” or Tertiary oration “3a” with the first words or name of the feast/saint being commemorated. Also indicated are the *Orationes Pro Diversitate Temporum Assignatae* found in the Missal that are offered in Sunday and Ferial Masses.

### Of Orations “Orationes pro diversitate temporum assignata”

From Candlemass to Ash Wednesday; at Mass the second oration after the Collect is 2a. is “Ad poscenda suffragia Sanctorum” (for the intercession of the saints) which begins “A cunctis nos, quaesumus” the third oration 3a. “Contra persecutores” (for the church) which begins “Protégé nos, Domine”.

### Of Ferias

On ferial days when no feast is given, the Mass of the preceding Sunday is offered but without the Gloria and the Creed and with the Preface of the Common. Additionally two more orations follow the Collect(s) as described above. A priest may at his discretion offer a Votive Mass ad libitum on a Feria day, e.g. a Requiem or a mystery or Saint, the Propers for which may be found in the Missal after the Propers of the Commons.

### PASCHALTIDE

The great Festival of Easter, the Queen of Feasts, will, of course, be celebrated with all the joy and splendour possible. The Altars will be adorned in a festive manner; the antependia or frontals, as well as the Vestments of the Clergy, should be white or of cloth of gold.

Easter Day is a privileged Sunday of the first class and it is also a Double Feast of the first class with an Octave. The Octave is also privileged, and it is impossible to celebrate any other Feast during this Octave; the Monday and Tuesday are Doubles of the first class but should be celebrated with a less degree of solemnity than Easter Day. Low Sunday, the Octave Day, is a Sunday of the first class and is to be observed in the same manner as a Double Feast.

At Mattins and Evensong on Easter Day, and daily until the following Saturday, there is no Office Hymn, but in its place should be sung, “This is the Day which the LORD hath made, we will rejoice and be glad in it.” (Psalm cxviii. 24). At the first Vespers of Low Sunday, and daily until the Eve of the Ascension, the Office Hymn should be Ad coenam Agni providi; and at Mattins on Low Sunday, and daily till Ascension Day, it should be Aurora lucis rutilat; or Rex sempiternae coelorum.

The proper Processional for Easter Day is Salve! Festa Dies.

If there be a Paschal Candle it should be placed on a large candelabrum stand-ing on the floor of the Sanctuary at the Gospel side of the Altar. It should be lighted at the Solemn Celebration of the Holy Eucharist and at Vespers on Easter Day and the two following days; also on the Saturday in Easter Week and on all Sundays till Ascension Day. It is also lighted on Ascension Day, but is extinguished at the end of the Gospel and removed at the conclusion of the Service.

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
